

APPLICATION PROCEDURES FOR TWO-YEAR MSW STUDENTS

STEP 1

Apply for admission to the MSW program in the School of Social Work (SSW) at the University of Alabama at Tuscaloosa. Obtain admission to the MSW program and enroll for the fall semester according to the SSW procedures.

STEP 2

December to April - At the end of the first semester in the MSW program students may apply for admission to the MPH program in the Department of Health Care Organization and Policy, Concentration in Maternal and Child Health Policy and Leadership at UAB School of Public Health.

School of Public Health application deadlines:

Priority deadline for financial aid applications is **March 1**.

Application deadline is **April 1**.

Applications for admission will be accepted until April 1. However, applications received after March 1 may not be eligible for financial assistance from the School of Public Health or the Department of Health Care Organization and Policy. Funds are awarded on a first-come first-serve basis to eligible students according to the application date.

GRADUATE RECORD EXAMINATION (GRE)

The School of Public Health requires all applicants to take the Graduate Record Examination (GRE) and submit an appropriate score that is less than five years old. The GRE should be taken prior to the application deadline for the School of Public Health. Applications will not be reviewed until an official GRE score report is submitted.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

STEP 3

Admitted students should contact the Department of Health Care Organization and Policy, Concentration in Maternal and Child Health Policy and Leadership for specific instructions on registration procedures. Dual degree students will begin taking MPH courses in the Summer term. Registration begins in March and ends in May. Registration must be completed prior to the first day of the Summer term.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES FOR MSW ADVANCED-STANDING STUDENTS (Spring Admission only)

MSW Advanced-Standing students who are admitted in the summer semester are not eligible for the Dual Degree program, but can apply separately to the MPH program at UAB.

STEP 1

Apply for admission to the MSW program in the School of Social Work (SSW) at the University of Alabama at Tuscaloosa. Obtain admission to the MSW program and enroll for the spring semester according to the SSW procedures.

STEP 2

Students who are admitted to the Advanced-Standing Program – Spring Admission in Social Work may apply to the MPH program during their first summer in the MSW program.

School of Public Health application deadlines:

Priority deadline for financial aid applications is **March 1**.

Application deadline is **April 1**.

Applications for admission will be accepted until April 1. However, applications received after March 1 may not be eligible for financial assistance from the School of Public Health or the Department of Health Care Organization and Policy. Funds are awarded on a first-come first-serve basis to eligible students according to the application date.

GRADUATE RECORD EXAMINATION (GRE)

The School of Public Health requires all applicants to take the Graduate Record Examination (GRE) and submit an appropriate score that is less than five years old.
